Agenda Item 1 — Call to Order: Mr. Balda, board president, called the meeting to order at 8:05 p.m.

Agenda Item 2 — Roll Call: The following Board members were present: Steve Balda, Heather Scully, Gary Woolever, LuAnn Brey and Mike Hartje. Absent: John Pearson and Jim Wiczorek. Also present: Tom Benson, District Administrator; Michele Butler, RAHS Associate Principal; Attorney Joe Hasler; Officers Scott Peterson and Gary Zellmer, student, student's mother and student's father.

Agenda Item 3 — Report on Public Notice: Notice of the meeting was given to the Reedsburg Independent, the Reedsburg Times Press, WRDB Radio and was posted at the Central Office Building, Reedsburg City Hall and the Reedsburg Public Library.

Agenda Item 4 — Consideration of Adjourning to Executive Session: The meeting was held in open session.

The Board was presented with evidence from high school administration and Officers Scott Peterson and Gary Zellmer, along with an administrative recommendation regarding appropriate discipline for the matter brought forward. The Board was also presented with information and respective arguments from the student and family members.

Sections 19.85(1)(a) and (1)(f) allow a meeting to be closed to the public when a governmental body is going to deliberate concerning a case which was the subject of any judicial or quasi-judicial trial or hearing before that governmental body, or where the governmental body considers financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons or the investigation of charges against specific persons which, if discussed in public would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or date or involved in such problems or investigations.

The purpose of the closed session is to deliberate in accordance with Section 120.13(1)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes and to review and discuss pupil records, as defined in Section 118.125 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Motion carried by a roll call vote 5-0.
