The Vine Street Program



The Vine Street Program offers credit deficient students the opportunity to earn a Reedsburg Area High School Diploma.

Students are required to maintain full-time student status, which includes 10 hours of class attendance each week, a minimum of 20 hours of employment per week, and 15 hours of community service per school year.

Other requirements include:

- Pass 5 federal GED tests
- Complete Employment Skills/Finance Skills Class at Vine Street
- Complete Civics at Vine Street or have earned 3 Social Studies credits
- Health course, test, or credit
- Career Assessment

Federal GED Tests

Students are required to take 5 federal GED tests. Tests are scheduled once the student has demonstrated readiness in each test area. All tests are taken at MATC.

Tests Include

- Math
- Social Studies
- Science
- Reading
- Writing

Each student will also develop a personal portfolio, which includes career and goal assessments, a personal budget, and a resume.

The Following applies to all Vine Street Program Students:

- Not allowed on the RAHS campus during school hours;
- Must maintain Vine Street Program Dress Code;
- May participate in sports and/or extracurricular events as long as full-time status is maintained;
- Receives High School Diploma from Reedsburg Area High School;
- Transcript shows deficient coursework as "passed by competency;"
- Will be suspended from program for lack of attendance or lack of employment.
