### LOCATION and DESCRIPTION

**RAHS** is a traditional, public, four-year high school. The current building, located on the southwest side of Reedsburg, was opened in 1998.

The district serves the city of Reedsburg, the villages of Ironton, LaValle, Loganville, Rock Springs, and nearby rural areas. The community is predominately white, middle income, residential.

Reedsburg's tax base is comprised of residential, service and retail, health care, tourism, and a variety of industrial businesses.

Reedsburg is located in northwestern Sauk County. Wisconsin Dells is 12 miles northeast, and Madison is 55 miles southeast.

### CURRICULUM

RAHS has a seven period schedule. Each class lasts 50 minutes. The school year has two 18-week semesters. A one-half credit course meets for one semester.
