2022-2027 Strategic Plan

The School District of Reedsburg's 2022-2027 Strategic Plan was developed during the winter of 2021 and spring of 2022 by a team of over 40 individuals, including representatives from every school, district and building administration, school board members, and local business and community members. It was approved unanimously by the School Board at its meeting on April 18, 2022.

The plan was enacted immediately, with District administration and staff working together to strategize and work on the tactical plans and priorities throughout the 2022-2023 school year. The school board and community received three progress updates.

In addition to Strategic Plan updates throughout the year, there is Strategic Plan Dashboard. This dashboard assists in easily communicating the progress of the goals in the 2022-2027 Strategic Plan. New data will be added throughout and after each school year as it becomes available.

Board of Education Approves Long-Term Facilities Plan

During its June 19, 2023, meeting, the School District of Reedsburg's Board of Education took action to approve the Long-Term Facilities Plan (LTFP). The LTFP recommends a future grade level configuration of 4K-1, 2-4, 5-8, and 9-12. There is no immediate facilities project that was approved as a part of the LTFP. This plan was developed over the course of the last 10 months, and it is directly connected to the District's strategic plan.

"The product of this work will not be a single project but a longterm plan that outlines a number of potential projects over time," states Superintendent Roger Rindo, Ed.D. "The 30-year facilities plan aims to improve teaching and learning opportunities for ALL students by aligning our future-focused instructional vision with more flexible and adaptable learning environments."

During its deliberations, the School Board recognized Webb Middle School requires a large investment in basic capital maintenance (plumbing, electrical, mechanical, and other systems). The LTFP also recognizes Reedsburg Area High School has facilities needs, including the development of more flexible learning spaces and renovations to support increases in rigorous academic programs and career pathways for all students. Further, the District acknowledges from the MDRoffers Community Growth & Projections Report an anticipated need for more capacity at the elementary level in the coming years.

Ultimately, the School Board approved a LTFP that places 5-8th grades at the middle school level. When opened, it would relieve any future capacity issues at the 4K-5 grade levels at least until 2036 or later.

Both staff and community feedback was critical to the long-term facilities planning process. The Board remains committed to that engagement as our facilities work moves forward.

The LTFP establishes a broad future direction for the district's facilities. There will be no immediate changes in grade-level





configuration. In the coming months, the School Board will consider how to phase implementation of the LTFP.

The District will not be able to immediately transition to four buildings even if a new 5-8 middle school opens. Making that eventual transition will require an addition to (or replacement of) Pineview Elementary at some point in the future.

Beginning in August, the Board will focus on further program and scope development, cost estimating, and financial analysis as we begin to evaluate and define a preliminary Phase One plan

that will be shared with stakeholders for feedback.

Rindo adds, "We will keep in mind our vision to provide a worldclass educational experience to all students as we move through the process of long-term facilities planning.
