

**Reedsburg Area High School - ACTIVITIES CODE & RULES SUMMARY
PLEDGE FORM - CLAY TARGET CLUB**

Code rules apply to all student-athletes on a year-round (12 month) basis. ALL parents and participants must be cognizant of the rules that affect eligibility. This pledge form contains a summary of rules and responsibilities that all participants in the Clay Target Club must follow.

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY & ATTENDANCE.

Grades: Grades are checked weekly to determine eligibility during activity season

Probation: 1 – “F” or less than a 1.67 GPA
(Can practice & play for 15 school days)

Ineligible: 2 – “F”s
(Can practice but no play for 15 school days)

AFTER 15 SCHOOL DAYS grades will be checked for student/athletes who are on probation or ineligible. If they are not passing all of their classes, these student athletes will lose the privilege to practice and compete IMMEDIATELY until all grades in all classes are at a passing level.

Attendance:

A student may participate in a co-curricular activity only if in attendance the **entire day** of the event. Exceptions to this rule are if a student has a pre-arranged professional appointment and/or family emergency.

ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, DRUG OR LOOK ALIKES & VIOLATIONS OF THE LAW

Use, Possession, Buying, Selling of Drugs &/or a Felony

1st Offense— 50% suspension from contests in a sports season
2nd Offense— 1 calendar year suspension from practices & competitions
3rd Offense--- Career suspension

Attendance at a “Social Gathering” where alcohol/drugs are present

1st Offense-- 25% suspension from contests in a sports season
2nd offense— 1 calendar year suspension from practices & competitions
3rd offense-- Career suspension

THEFT, VANDALISM, VIOLENCE, DISORDERLY CONDUCT, HAZING & HARASSMENT, DISRUPTION OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROCESS (INCLUDING INAPPROPRIATE USE OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES OR MEDIA), AND/OR ANY VIOLATION OF ANY CRIMINAL STATUTE

1st Offense— 25% suspension from contests in a sports season
2nd offense— 1 calendar year suspension from practices & competitions
3rd offense-- Career suspension

CONDUCT UNBECOMING A PARTICIPANT

Any behaviors that are outside of commonly held expectations of athletes & participants, which may involve actions or disciplinary measures not specifically covered by the Code of Conduct, and Student Handbook may be classified as conduct unbecoming.

ENFORCEMENT: All suspensions are **enforced immediately** after discovery and verification of the violation has occurred. All contest suspensions must be immediate and contests must be consecutive.

PARENTAL GUIDE TO SPORTSMANSHIP

I (we) pledge to follow these guidelines of sportsmanship, respect and ethics as they relate to my (our) son / daughter participation in RAHS athletics. I (we) accept that any deviation from these guidelines and expectations may result in disciplinary consequences.

WEAPONS ON SCHOOL PROPERTY Policy # 5772 for the School District of Reedsburg: (summary)

The Board of Education prohibits students from possessing, storing, making, or using a weapon in any setting that is under the control and supervision of the District. The District Administrator will refer any student who violates this policy to the student’s parents or guardians and may also make a referral to the criminal justice or juvenile delinquency system. The student may also be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including removal from the Clay Target Club and expulsion from the school district.
